IO1- Performing Arts Curriculum

All of the content is ready in English and all partner languages, and each partner has piloted the curriculum in their countries with at least 12 performing artists.

IO2- In-Service Training for VET Professionals

All of the content for the In-service Training Programme has been completed and translated into all partner languages, and the in-service training has been implemented with VET tutors in each partner country.

IO3- MOOC

Final touches are being made to the STARDUST MOOC, and all project materials in all languages will be hosted on the platform by the end of the project lifecycle.
